6. Between 1 and 4 who is the stouter skulled and more pulled apart in her chest? 1
7. Between 3 and 4 which gilt gets out with the longer stride and has the better hip and hind leg? 4

8. Which is the deep chested ewe? 2
9. Which ewe turns in the most at her hock? 1
10. Which ewe best combines balance and muscularity? 3
11. Who is the tall framed and most extended ewe in the class? 4

13. Which ewe is the heavy bootied with most shag? 1
14. Between 1 and 3 which ewe is the heavier boned with the bigger foot? 1
